

Bahrain To Qualify Cos For Tubli Wastewater Treatment Proj-Report

Bahrain will call companies within the coming months to qualify for a wastewater treatment project in the Tubli region in the eastern part of the country, Manama-based Al Wasat reports Tuesday citing Khalifa Al Mansour, assistant undersecretary for the sewage department at Bahrain's ministry of works.

The project involves setting up a new wastewater treatment plant with a daily capacity of 200 cubic meters under a build, own, operate, or BOO, contract, in addition to six kilometers of sewage pipelines, the paper reports.

The ministry is seeking to complete the qualification of the companies and then to issue requests for proposals for the tender's bids within the coming two months, it adds.
