

DEWA to invite IWPP bids in March

Saeed al-Tayer, chief executive of Dubai Electricity and Water Authority (Dewa) has announced plans to float the tender for its planned large-scale Hassyam power and seawater desalination complex, which will be developed by the private sector in March, Zawya Dow Jones has reported. "We will float a tender in March and we expect to commission it (the plant) in three years by 2014," he said. The 1,500MW power station and 120million-imperial-gallons-a-day desalination complex will be implemented on an independent water and power project (IWPP) basis.
