

Egypt Announces 16 Water, Drainage Tenders

Correspondent) -- Egyptian public and private companies last week announced 16 tenders in the water and drainage sectors. The first tender from the Potable Water and Sanitary Drainage Company in Qena involves the supply of spare parts for compact water filtration plants including chemical equipment, injection pumps, compressors, mixers and air blowers using funding from German development bank KfW. The bid bond is \$4,165 USD. The deadline for submitting bids is March 8, 2011. The next five tenders were announced by the General Department for Beni Swef Irrigation. They involve mechanical dredging and purging of canals at various locations and removal of aquatic weeds under four contracts. The bid bonds are \$2,280 USD, \$2,456 USD, \$1,754 USD and \$1,754 USD. The performance bonds are 5 percent each and the deadlines for submitting bids are March 7-8, 2011. The next two tenders were announced by the Potable Water and Sanitary Drainage Company in Aswan. They involve rehabilitation of sewer covers and valve rooms along discharge pipelines in Aswan City and supply of pumps and related spare parts. The bid bonds are \$1,000 USD and \$3,000 USD. The deadlines for submitting bids are March 8 and 9, 2011.

The ninth and tenth tenders, announced by the Potable Water and Sanitary Drainage Company in Minya are for civil and mechanical works for sanitary drainage water in Abu Qorqas under two contracts. The bid bonds are \$877 USD and \$526 USD, respectively, and the deadline for submitting bids is March 9, 2011. The eleventh through thirteenth tenders were announced by the Potable Water Company of Alexandria. They involve supply of tables for the calibration of potable water meters, ductile cast iron valves and design, manufacturing and supply of fuse and butterfly type valves. The bid bonds are \$7,894 USD, \$2,631 USD and \$17,543 USD. The deadlines for submitting bids are March 8, 12 and 14, 2011. The fourteenth and fifteenth tenders from the General Department for West Monoufeyya Drainage involve covering canals at various locations under two contracts. The bid bonds are \$526 USD and \$789 USD. The performance bonds are 5 percent each. The deadlines for submitting bids are March 14 and 15, 2011. The sixteenth tender, announced by the General Department for Drainage Projects in Central Egypt, Beni Swef, involves construction of the subsurface (tile) drainage networks at El-Fahmiyyin and West El-Fahmiyyin Zone. The bid bond is \$13,175 USD. The deadline for submitting bid is March 10, 2011.
