

Eleven Water, Drainage Tenders Announced in Egypt

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CAIRO, Egypt (OOSKAnews Corre...) — Egyptian public and private companies last week announced 11 tenders in the water and drainage sectors.

The first and second tenders were announced by the General Department for West Kafr El-Sheikh Irrigation. They involve civil, mechanical and electrical works for two standby irrigation pumping stations on Shalma Canal and Mofteh Canal.

The bid bonds are \$7,017 USD and \$2,982 USD, and the performance bond is 5 percent of the value of each contract.

The deadline for submitting bids for both is February 24, 2011.

The Potable Water and Sanitary Drainage Company of Fayyoun issued the third, fourth and fifth tenders for rehabilitation and replacement of potable water pipelines of 225, 450 and 315 millimeter diameter at various locations under three contracts.

The bid bonds are \$877 USD, \$4,385 USD and \$1,403 USD. The performance bonds are 5 percent each. The deadline for submitting bids is also February 24, 2011.

The sixth and seventh tenders were issued by the same company and involve building finishing and connection points between potable water networks in Markaz Tamia and Markaz Ibshway under two contracts.

The bid bonds are \$614 USD each. The performance bond is 5 percent of the value of each contract.

The deadline for submitting bids is February 26, 2011.

The eighth and ninth tenders, also announced by the Potable Water and Sanitary Drainage Company of Fayyoun, include maintenance and raising efficiency of two sanitary drainage discharge lines in El-Lagoon and El-Roda under two contracts.

The bid bonds are \$877 USD each. The performance bond is 5 percent of the value of each contract. The deadlines for submitting bids are February 27 and 28, 2011.

The tenth and eleventh tenders were announced by the Potable Water and Sanitary Drainage Company in Kafr El-Sheikh.

They involve supply of a high-pressure single-phase horizontal Case-Split type water filtration unit of 450 liters/second discharge and supply and erection of electrical automatic butterfly valves for the purifiers' sludge control valves and other electric valves for the enhanced purifier, along with electrical switchboards and cables for those valves.

The bid bonds are \$1,140 USD and \$701 USD. The performance bonds are 5 percent each. The deadlines for submitting bids are February 27 and 28, 2011.

Meanwhile, the General Department for Irrigation Development Projects in West Delta has requested an offer from eligible specialized companies for supply and erection of a low-voltage electricity network to feed mesqas (small irrigation canals) along El-Beda Canal, Geziret El-Gamaa Canal, El-Tera'a El-Adima Main Canal, El-Mallaha Canal and King Osman Canal within Markaz Kafr El-Dawar, Beheira.

The bid bond is \$21,000 USD. The performance bond is 5 percent. The deadline for submitting bids is February 23, 2011.
