

H.H. Sheikh Hamad Bin Mohammed Al Sharqi inaugurates the Fujairah 2 Independent Power and Water Plant

International Power - GDF SUEZ Middle East, Turkey & Africa is pleased to announce that the Fujairah F2 Independent Power and Water Plant that it developed together with project partners Abu Dhabi Water and Electricity Authority (ADWEA), Abu Dhabi National Energy Company (TAQA) and Marubeni Corporation of Japan, was inaugurated by H.H. Sheikh Hamad Bin Mohammed Al Sharqi, Supreme Council Member and Ruler of Fujairah and H.H. Sheikh Mansour Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Presidential Affairs, United Arab Emirates.

The plant, which is located in Qidfa in the Emirate of Fujairah on the Gulf of Oman, produces 2,000 MW of power and almost 600,000 m³/day of water. It was constructed by an EPC consortium of Alstom and SIDEM. It is owned by the Fujairah Asia Power Company (FAPCO) in which IPR-GDF SUEZ has a 20% equity interest, with 60% held between ADWEA & TAQA and 20% by Marubeni. The electricity and water produced is sold via a 20-year Power and Water Purchase Agreement to the Abu Dhabi Water and Electricity Company (ADWEC). The facility is operated by a 50/50 joint venture between IPR - GDF SUEZ and Marubeni.

Shankar Krishnamoorthy, CEO and President of IPR - GDF SUEZ Middle East, Turkey & Africa commented, "This is the first inauguration in the Middle East since GDF SUEZ Energy International and International Power combined their businesses in February. We are proud that we can celebrate it in the United Arab Emirates, where we also have our Regional Headquarters. The combined company has a strong track record in the region for both operational performance and successful project delivery, as evidenced today by the Fujairah F2 project."

He added, "High demand for power in the region continues to offer great opportunities for leading developers and investors such as IPR - GDF SUEZ and we remain committed to delivering safe, competitive and reliable solutions for the region's needs."
