

JSRE, Spanish firm seal MoU

Amman, Feb 13 (Petra) - The Jordanian Society for Renewable Energy (JSRE) on Sunday signed a memorandum of understanding with the Spanish Millennium Energy Industries (MEI) for cooperation in solar air conditioning systems technology.

The memo, signed by JSRE President, HRH Prince Asem Bin Nayef, includes using an electrical system with 25kw capacity at the JSRE new building, which will be constructed in the Amman suburb of Abu Nsair, and will entirely depend on renewable energy systems.

The new building will provide a practical and technical model for renewable energy and environment researchers to help in the adaptation of new patterns of positive handling of energy, water and environment.

Solar air conditioning systems are getting worldwide attention due to their feasibility in dry arid climates and areas remote from the electric grid.
