

Omani firm to build solar park for Saudi Aramco

Saudi Aramco has awarded Oman-based Phoenix Solar the contract to build a solar park with a peak power of 3.5 megawatts in the kingdom, Oman Daily Observer has reported. The solar power plant is to be built on a land where the King Abdullah Petroleum Studies and Research Centre is currently under construction close to Riyadh. Together with Naizak Global Engineering Systems, its local project partner in Saudi Arabia, Phoenix Solar will design and build the grid-connected ground-mounted photovoltaic plant by the end of September 2011.
